WRI is a registered charity and has not received government funding for the Wildlife Hospital to date. In order to continue to offer our services to injured and orphaned wild animals, we need someone to help us raise funds.

Duties:

- Design and produce promotional materials
- Raise awareness of the organisation's work, goals, and financial needs
- Develop corporate fundraising programs
- Compile or develop materials to submit to granting or other funding organisations
- Recruit sponsors, participants, or volunteers for fundraising events
- Identify and build relationships with potential donors
- Develop fundraising activity plans that maximize participation or contributions and minimize costs
- Direct or coordinate web-based fundraising activities
- Write and send letters of thanks to donors
