



Volunteer Position: MAINTENANCE

As Covid-19 was the catalyst for the emergency creation of WRI's Wildlife Hospital, we are temporarily using stables and a barn to house the animals whilst concurrently building the planned long term Wildlife Hospital and Visitor Centre in the field behind it. As such, there is a tremendous amount of work to adapt the stables to suit wildlife instead of horses! Then there is the extremely exciting new build of all the enclosures on the greenfield site behind the stables.

Duties:

- Making large mammal cages
- Making net bottomed cages for ducklings and waterbirds
- Making nest boxes for birds, cages for hedgehogs
- Maintenance and light repairs; fixing broken doors, appliances etc
- Undertake light installation or carpentry (e.g. building shelving, frames for animal pools, outdoor sink area)
- Assist other tradespeople with electrical, plumbing, roofing etc
- Building aviaries and animal enclosures

Requirements:

- Well-organised with strong general repair skills
- A keen eye for detail and good physical stamina
- Ideally full driving licence and own transport and tools
- Ideally able to commit to one full day per week

Training: detailed designs/instructions provided

Location: Wildlife Hospital, Tara Na Ri, Garlow Cross, Navan, Co Meath, C15 V9TW. Some carpentry work can also, be done from home if you have the tools.
