



### **Professional Support: Wildlife Teaching Hospital Fundraiser**

This is intended as a practical fundraising role within an active working group helping to move the project forward, rather than a purely advisory position. This is a chance to join an active project at an important stage of development and help shape the fundraising work needed to bring Ireland's proposed Wildlife Teaching Hospital closer to reality.

Current needs are likely to include:

- developing and progressing fundraising strategy for the hospital project
- identifying and approaching suitable donors and funders
- shaping and progressing funding asks for major donors and philanthropic supporters
- preparing donor materials, presentations, and case-for-support documents
- helping move the project through its readiness, mobilisation, capital, and early operational fundraising stages

This may be a voluntary, reduced-rate, contract, or paid role, depending on the experience offered, the nature of the role, and available funding.
